Washtenaw Christian Academy's Statement of Faith

The School is a Christian school and its Statement of Faith is as follows:

1. We believe the Bible to be divinely inspired and the only infallible, authoritative and inerrant Word of God. (*2 Timothy 3:16, 2 Peter 1:21*).
2. We believe there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. (*Genesis 1:1, Matthew 28:19, John 10:30*)
3. We believe in the deity of Christ (*John 10:33*), His virgin birth (*Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:23, Luke 1:35*), His sinless life (*Hebrews 4:15, Hebrews 7:26*), His miracles (*John 2:11*), His vicarious and atoning death (*1 Corinthians 15:3, Ephesians 1:7, Hebrews 2:9*), His resurrection (*John 11:25, 1 Corinthians 15:4*), His ascension to the right hand of the Father (*Mark 16:19*) and His personal return in power and glory (*Acts 1:11, Revelation 19:11*).
4. We believe in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature; and that we are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ and that only by God's grace and through faith alone are we saved (*John 2:16-19, John 5:24, Romans 3:23, Romans 5:8-9, Ephesians 2:8-10, Titus 3:5*).
5. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost: those that are saved are raised into everlasting life, and those that are lost are raised into eternal damnation (*John 5:28-29*).
6. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life (*Romans 8:13-14, 1 Corinthians 3:16, 1 Corinthians 6:19-20, Ephesians 4:30, Ephesians 5:18*).
7. We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (*Romans 8:9, 1 Corinthians 12:12-13, Galatians 3:26-28*).
