Washtenaw Christian Academy is a pre-school through twelfth grade school that is college-preparatory in nature. Since 1977 we have been committed to excellence in all we do and we continue with this strong resolve to this day.

Our students from elementary to high school take part in the Stanford Achievement Test each year. On average, over the past 3 years, our students have consistently scored in the 70th - 90th percentile range on all subject areas tested. This means that our students are scoring the same as or better than 70-90% of students who take this test nationwide.

Our high school students, on average, score in the 600 range in math and verbal on the SAT. Likewise, the average composite score on the ACT is 22. These results tell us that students from our school are scoring at or above the National average on college entrance exams.

Socially our students have many opportunities. Washtenaw Christian Academy is a member of the MHSAA (Michigan High School Athletics Association). Besides numerous sports opportunities, there are a variety of clubs and social events that our students participate in. Our school is known for having a safe and friendly environment, where students can grow, learn, and thrive.
