\*The following change in requirements begins with the class of 2006:

- ½ credit in American Government
- ½ credit in Economics
- 1 credit in American History (U.S. History)
- 1 credit in World History (NEW)
- 1 elective in Social Studies
- 4 credits in Social Studies Total

A Social Studies credit from the Bible class Understanding the Times may be granted. The credit will count only once for both GPA purposes and cumulative total credit requirements. IE: Students who use it for social studies credit have it applied to that credit, and can use it to also fulfill WCA's requirement of 1 of 4 credit hours in Bible. However it counts as only 1 credit. Students would need to pick up 1 additional credit to apply to their cumulative credit requirement.

\*\*Where a student can provide documentation of 90 hours of sports, dance, and gymnastics in a given year, that student can receive a ½ credit. The other ½ credit requirement in health education would remain the same.
