

# Answers to Your Questions About the WCA 100 Hole Golf Marathon!

1. **What if I am not a good golfer, or do not golf at all?** You can still play! We will arrange for another person to ride with you, or you can find someone. You will play as a team. That person will take as many of the shots FOR YOU as you wish. It could be all of them, or just the first drive. Maybe you will just do the putting. This is easy and fun.
2. **How does the Golf Marathon work?** Each golfer will have a cart. You will golf with one other person in another cart. Each golfer will quickly hit the ball, drive to the ball, hit it again (until you reach the green), and then putt quickly. You never hit the ball more than 3 times over par. For example, if par is 4 swings, you hit the ball no more than 7 times. After 7 swings, you pick the ball up and move quickly to the next hole. You do not look for lost balls. You hit as soon as you are ready.
3. **What about the shorter holes?** Some of the holes are very short. On these holes you hit 3 balls from the tee, not one. Then, you play all 3 to the green. This counts as 3 holes played.
4. **How long will it take to play 100 holes?** You can skip around to different holes. It will probably take about 5-6 hours.
5. **Can I combine my 100 holes with someone else?** Of course! If a husband and wife team, or two men or women, want to combine their totals, then you golf 50 holes each. You would simply collect pledges as part of a team that is going to golf 100 holes.
6. **What if I don't have golf clubs?** We will arrange that with you. The clubs are not a problem.
7. **What if I can't get there by 7:30am?** We will make arrangements for you to come as soon as you can!
8. **What do I wear?** You can dress as casual as you want. Be comfortable, this is very informal.
9. **Will there be food provided?** Yes, we will have coffee, donuts and rolls in the morning. Lunch will be provided at the

- clubhouse as you pass by during the day. Also, hot and cold drinks will be delivered to you on the course.
10. **What if it rains?** We will play rain or shine. The only weather stopping us will be thunderstorms. These are unlikely in the morning.
  11. **How do I benefit from others golfing?** If you have a friend who is willing to golf and raise pledges, we will credit YOUR tuition for next year, 40% of anything your friend raises above \$200. For example, if your friend \$1,000 you will receive 40% of \$800 or \$320.
  12. **How much of my pledges go to my tuition bill?** For each golfer, the first \$500 pledged goes to the school fundraiser. After that, you receive a tuition credit for next year of 40% of anything raised. NO limit! If you raise \$2,500, you will receive \$800 in tuition credits.
  13. **Can I have more than one friend do this?** Yes, this helps you and the school.
  14. **If I am a “serious golfer” can I play slower?** Sure. What we suggest (for a team of 2) is 2 rounds of 18 holes, hitting 3 balls on the shorter holes. That will give you 2 nice rounds of golf, totaling 100 holes as a team of 2. You will have to let the faster players go past you.
  15. **Do I have to pledge myself?** It is much easier to raise money from others if you pledge yourself. It shows them that you are serious about what you are doing.
  16. **Can you help me with knowing how to ask for pledges?** Yes! We have suggested scripts, plus we will personally sit down with you can work on this.
  17. **Will I have to collect from all the people who pledge?** It will help us for you to collect. We will be sending out an invoice to each person. All tuition credits are based on collections of pledges.
