



## WASHTENAW CHRISTIAN ACADEMY PRESCHOOL ENRICHMENT CLASS

Starting in the fall of 2007, the preschool program is offering an enrichment class for older four-year-old children and young five-year-old children. The class will meet from 12:15 to 3:15 p.m. on Monday, Wednesday and Friday with Mrs. Ann Fahlstrom. The class size will be a maximum of seven children.

The enrichment class will have a different curriculum than our morning class. The program will still have:

- Circle time (scripture, prayer, calendar, etc.)
- Center play (ex. sensory tables, home living, reading, puzzles, etc.)
- Snack time
- Outdoor or large motor activity

What makes this enrichment class different is that our topics/themes are primarily based on the class' interest. Depending on the class interest, the topic could last from one week to possibly three weeks. Mrs. Fahlstrom will look at the experiences the children are most interested in and expand on the child's understanding of their experiences.

For example, the children are interested in trucks. Here is an example of how we will expand on their knowledge:

- What is inside of a truck looks like and draw interior pictures
- How the engine starts and loading and unloading procedures
- Learn to ask questions of the truck driver to expand their knowledge
- Measuring the length and width of the seats
- Make a bar graph of the different types of trucks
- Dictating and illustrating a truck story
- Creating their own truck out of whatever materials they would like ☺
- They could even create a mini-play or puppet show
